The Rutherford Civic Association President, Mary Ann Beck, just received this message from Sharon Bulova, and wanted to let everyone know about the special county yard waste pick up. Dear Community Association President:

The recent storms before and during the July 4th weekend caused a significant amount of damage in some areas of the Braddock District. Downed trees and limbs caused some damage to several homes in our area. In a few areas, utility lines were down, and power was out. Earlier this week, my staff and I visited some of the damaged areas, including the Long Branch Stream Valley Trail.

Since the storms, county staff and private citizens have been busy cleaning up the mess. One challenge has been what to do with the large piles of debris that have resulted from the clean-up.

At my request, county staff has agreed to arrange **special pick-ups for yard waste and debris from the storm**. If you and your neighbors can get the yard waste and storm debris to the curb, my office will make arrangements with the County for it to be picked up. Please tell your neighbors to call Diane Thompson on my staff at 703-425-9300 if they are interested in taking advantage of this one-time pick-up opportunity.

With a little more hard work, we can clean up this mess. Thank you for your efforts to keep up the appearance of the Braddock District.
